



## Cardiovascular Nurse Specialist Program

**Goal:** Prepare nurses with the knowledge, skills, and attitudes of cardiovascularly-trained nurses and improve patient care outcomes.

**Program Description:** The Cardiovascular Nurse Specialty (CVNS) Program is a unique interdisciplinary program that combines didactic material and in-depth clinical experience. This Program will provide a blended-learning approach towards cardiovascular nursing specialization, with the intent of passing the certification exam for the cardiovascular specialty area.

- **Length:** 12 weeks, with a 12-hour commitment each week.
  - 4-hours of didactic sessions; 2-hours of simulation scenarios; 6-hours of practicum.
- **Cost:** \$4,800.
- **Eligibility Criteria:** Any graduate from an accredited nursing program with an active unencumbered RN License or recent graduates with a GPA of 3.5 or above and eligible to sit for the National Council Licensure Examination (NCLEX).

### Program Relevance:

- Provides a workforce pipeline for the cardiovascular specialty line of service;
- Addresses the anticipated challenges of the changing demographics of registered nurses, an aging population, and health care system reform;
- Supports both the needs of the lifelong learner and organizations as they transform to provide enhanced quality care outcomes.

- ✓ Provide safe, quality and specialized care for patients with cardiovascular disease.
- ✓ Use of evidence for clinical decision making.
- ✓ Enhanced professional confidence and competence as evidenced by passing National Certification Exam.
